The consensus decisions taken in this conference will be forwarded to the ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs , Govt of India & Urban Ministries of different states.



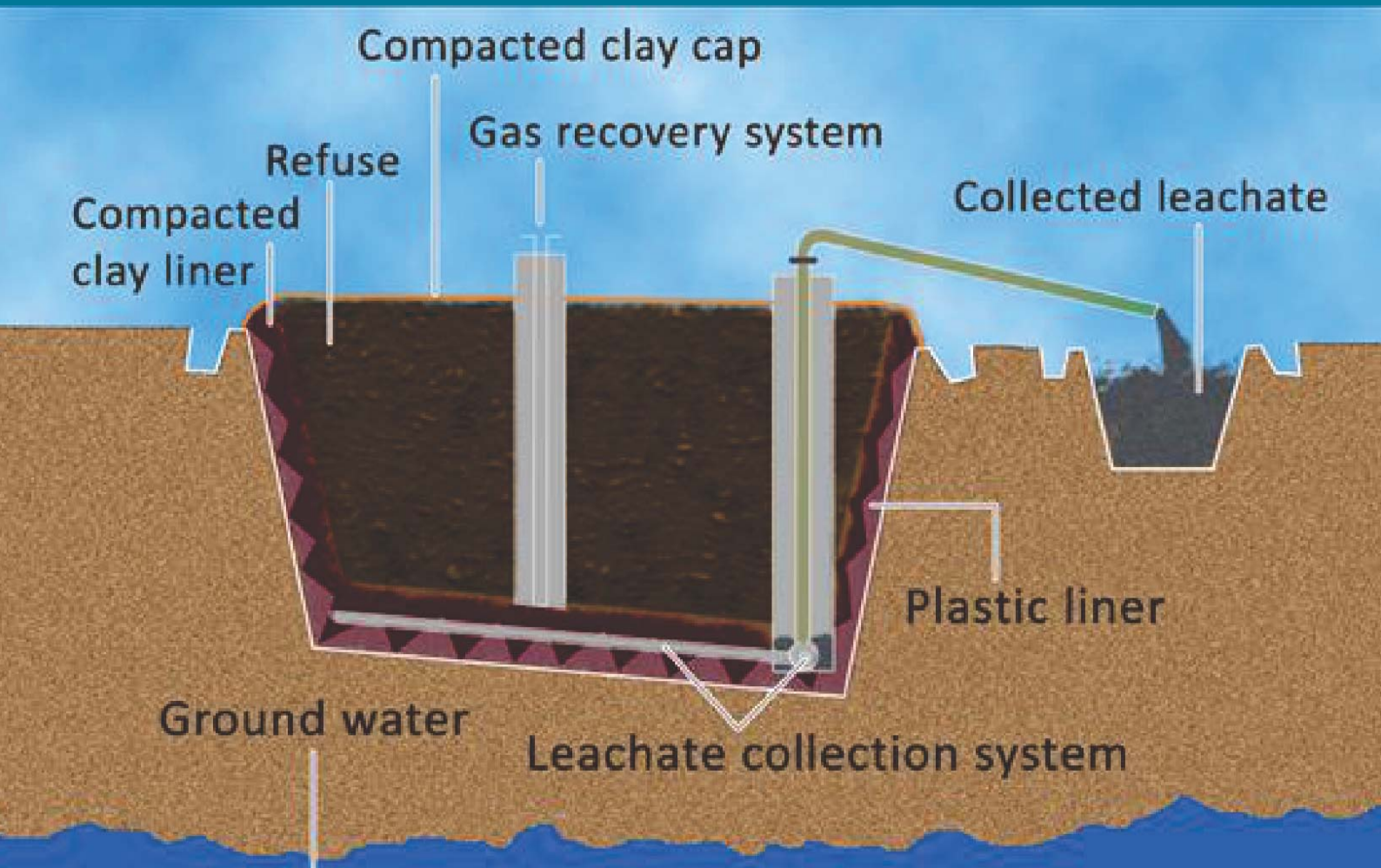
Confederation of Resident Welfare Associations (CoRWA)

CORWA UP (CONFEDERATION OF RWAS – UTTAR PRADESH)

CoRWA – UP is a registered body of RWAs at the State level of Uttar Pradesh . Its objectives include liaison with the concerned authorities , coordination and converging Civil Society Consensus in One Voice in respect of major common issues and raise voice against lack of transp



Usually, in RWAs, there is no room for indifference and non-cooperation. The office bearers of CoRWA-UP provide considerable number of hours for the service of the community voluntarily without any cost to the community unlike the Parliament, Legislatures and Municipalities, whose administrative costs are usually very high and questionable. At the RWA level, there is no scope for delays, since those who suffer are the stakeholders themselves. There is no scope for corruption since the interested parties themselves are the beneficiaries. The quality of works carried out would be maximum, since they cannot pass on the blame to others. Finally, there is no need for social audit .Hence, CoRWA -UP demands that RWAs should not only be given constitutional recognition, they should also be given a share in the financial out lay for the Urban Local Bodies(ULB) as per the 74th amendment and Article 232 of the Indian Constitution; they should logically be given priority over other paid public representatives . aency in the decision making or neglect of civic amenities by municipal bodies and development authorities.

FOFG (FLAT OWNER FEDERATION GHAZIABAD)



Flat Owners Federation Ghaziabad was earlier registered as Apartment Owners Associations Federation Ghaziabad on 19 January 2015 by the Dy Registrar, Chit Funds and Societies Registration. Apartment Owners Associations from Indrapuram, Vaishali, Vasundhara, Mohan Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Kavi Nagar and City Zone joined it in quick succession. It demands that Federation should be given the right to facilitate elections and audit in the high rise societies in terms of clause 48 of the Model Apartment Bye laws of UP Govt.
